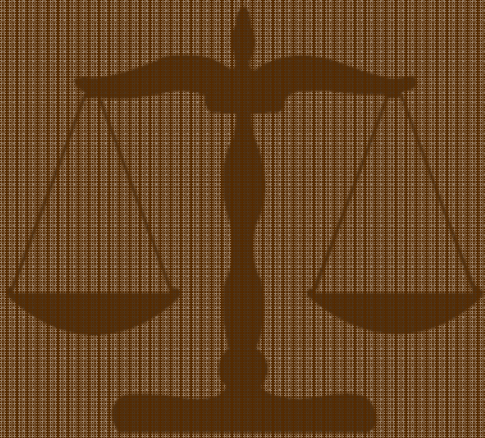

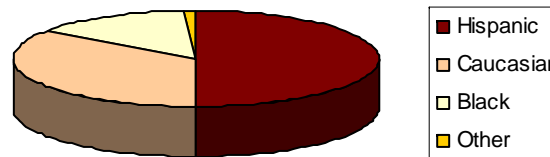

## Opportunities for Equal Justice During 2009

- **367** clients were helped with custody and visitation cases.
- **542** clients were helped through the divorce/separation/annulment process and **173** were helped out of a domestic violence situation in cooperation with Lubbock Women's Protective Services.
- **6** clients took advantage of the wills/estates program.
- Of the **1,097** clients, almost **900** were women.
- Over **\$77,000** in back/unpaid child support was gained on behalf of our clients.
